ST JOHN PAUL II AND THE FSSP



The story goes that Fr Josef Bisig and eleven other priests got together at the Abbey of Hauterive (Switzerland) in July of 1988 and on the bench you see to the right, drew up the basic plans to request what would become the Priestly Fraternity of St. Peter.

Working closely with Cardinal Ratzinger they presented their desire to the Holy Father, to be established as a society of apostolic life, tasked to preserve Tradition within the church.

His Holiness St. John Paul II quickly took this new religious congregation under his care, establishing the Fraternity in a historical record time - within three months the Fraternity was erected as a Clerical Society of Pontifical Rite. This same process usually takes years for other religious congregations!



And the name? Until the Fraternity, no one dared to use the name of St. Peter, as it was reserved for the Vatican and the Pope. However Cardinal Ratzinger suggested that since His Holiness had established the Fraternity to provide this special service for the Pope of preserving the Liturgical Traditions within the Catholic Church, we should be given the name of St. Peter, showing our commission from the Papal Office.
