


ongratulations to Brother Mark Charbel for the reception of his Habit yesterday and the beginning of his novitiate! May God bless your vocation!





A THOUGHT FOR SUNDAY

would often tell us of another community who would not save their food from one day to the next.

They would trust in God to provide them with the food each day - that some random person would bring to the door of the monastery - and whatever was left over they would give to the poor.

While this is a truly heroic practice of the virtue of trust, it would be sinful for the father of a family to attempt this, since prudence requires effort to be made to provide your family with food. Nevertheless the virtue of trust in God plays a special role in our daily lives. We need to know that if we fulfill the mandate of Genesis to work for our daily bread, God will provide us with it.

Los Angeles is probably one of the more difficult locations to make ends meet, or to get started. But this is where that confidence and trust in God become more meritorious. To know that He has care for us is such a consolation. If we were truly on our own we wouldn't stand a chance.

In the end, as St. Augustine would say: "Pray as if everything depended on God. Then work as if everything depends on you."
