Low Sunday

A THOUGHT FOR SUNDAY

Divine Mercy Sunday is what this Sunday is usually called these days. It's been through many names over the centuries - almost like us asking: how do you follow up after everything that just happened in the Triduum and Easter Sunday last week?

The name Low Sunday commonly came from the fact that exhausted choirs would usually take this Sunday off. So it was kind of a "Low Mass Sunday".

But the title of Divine Mercy is quite a fitting follow-up to, as the Disciples of Emmaus put it: *what happened this past weekend* (Lk 24).

With Our Redeemer's sacrificial death and resurrection, He attained grace and mercy for us, restoring our fallen nature and opening the Gates, gave us a chance of Heaven.

Today we commemorate how He bestows that Mercy upon us.

People get carried away with God's perfection of Mercy. It is *not* unconditional, and it is *not* greater than God's Justice. It is *equal* to God's Justice, because God is infinite in all His perfections. (Which incidentally is only one perfection - God's Justice is His Mercy.) And it is conditional because it requires something on our part: *repentance*.

Our Savior Himself said to not throw pearls to the swine (Mt 7). If we do not want His Mercy, Our Lord will not give it to us!

So on this Sunday let us pray for Mercy, conform to God's grace, then pray for the conversion of those who need to desire His Mercy and conform to the grace He is sending them.
