A truly humble person acts and thinks as if they have no idea whether they are humble or not. Because they are not thinking of themselves. This opens them up for more care of neighbor, more charity, and ultimately more love of God.

AN ACT OF CONTRITION

For several years now we have lived in an education system that detests memorization. This unfortunately has consequences, for example many Catholics do not know an Act of Contrition. Countless times when it comes time in confession to make the act of contrition the penitent says: "Father I don't know an act of contrition."

This is problematic, because if you don't know your act of contrition, how do you tell God that you're sorry at the end of the day? Or do you tell God you're sorry at the end of the day?

Here is a good act of contrition. Included in red is an explanation of what it's saying. If you do not know one, memorize this one:

Oh my God I am heartily sorry that I have offended Thee.

(Sorry with all my heart - expressing that this is an act of the will (which is important) but using common language.)

I detest all my sins because I dread the loss of Heaven and the pains of Hell;

(This is honestly how we feel but manifests imperfect contrition.)

but most of all because they have offended Thee my God, who art all good and deserving of all my love.

(This expresses true perfect contrition.)

I firmly resolve with the help of Thy grace,

(Because we need God's grace to do good and avoid evil. This shows our dependence on Him.)

to sin no more and to avoid the near occasion of sin. Amen.

(This shows our resolution not only to stop sinning but to avoid the occasion that put us in proximity to sinning again. This is important.)

There is an alternate ending to this act of contrition to be used outside the confessional, when you make your Act of Contrition with your night prayers:

I firmly resolve with the help of Thy grace to confess my sins, to do penance and to amend my life. Amen.)
