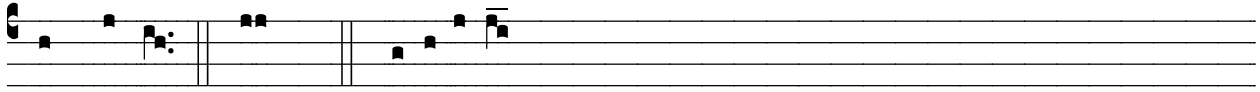


O LORD, let the light of your countenance shine upon us! You put gladness into my heart.
