






Lord, let your face shine on us, al - le - lu - ia.

4. As soon as I lie down, I fall peacefully asleep,

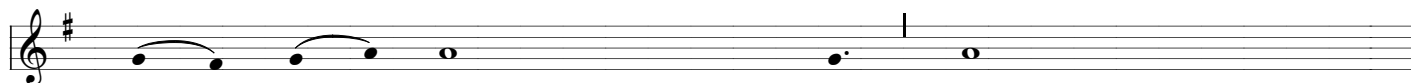


1. you who relieve me when I am in distress;
