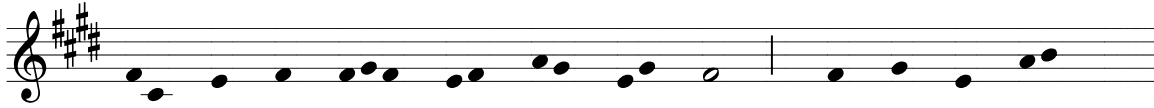


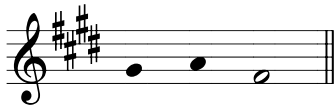
Eastertide—Seasonal Psalm

This is the day the Lord has made; let us re-joice

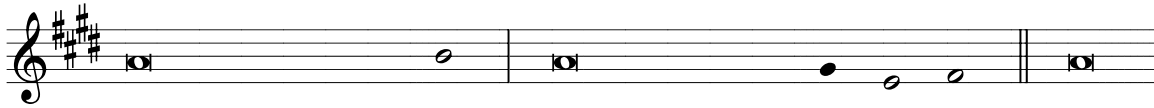

Give thanks to the *Lord*, for he is good, for his mercy endures for- ev- er.

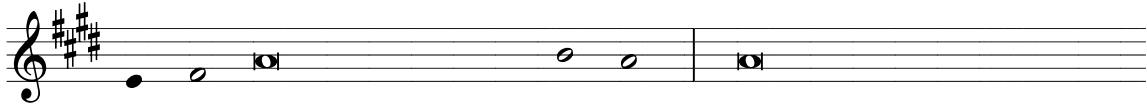

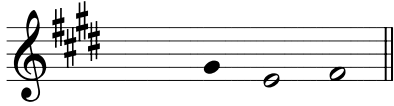

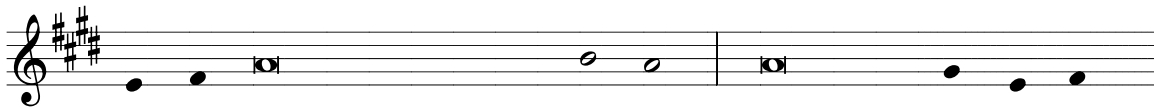


The right hand of the Lord is ex-alt- ed; the *right* hand of the Lord has
