




I will sing to the LORD, for he is gloriously tri-umphant; horse and chariot he has cast into the




sea. My strength and my courage is the LORD, and he has been my savior. He is my God, I



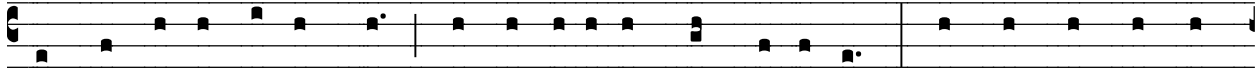
praise him; the God of my father, I extol him. **Let us sing...**



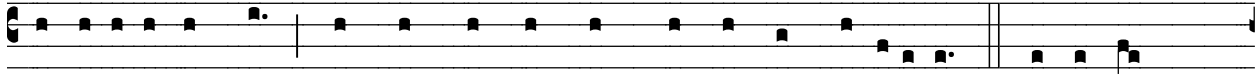
The LORD is a warrior, LORD is his name! Pharaoh's chariots and army he hurled into the sea;



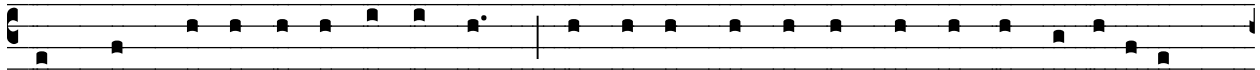
the elite of his of-ficers were submerged in the Red Sea. **Let us sing...**



The flood waters covered them, they sank into the depths like a stone. Your right hand, O LORD,



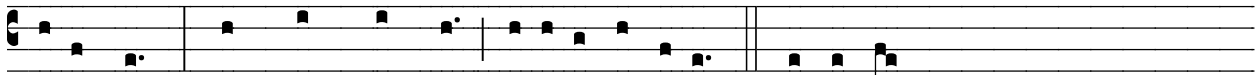
magnificent in power, your right hand, O LORD, has shattered the enemy. **Let us sing...**
