

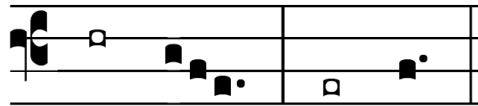

Ps 31 : 1-2. 5. 7. 11 **12**

1. Blessèd is the one whose fault is taken *away*, \*  
whose sin is **covered**.
2. Blessèd the man to whom the Lord *imputes no guilt*, \*  
in whose spirit there is no **guile**. (R̃.)
3. I acknowledged my *sin to you*, \*  
my guilt I covered **not**.
4. I said, / “ I confess my faults *to the Lord*, ” \*  
and you took away the guilt of my **sin**. (R̃.)
5. You are my shelter ; / from distress you *will preserve* me ; \*  
with glad cries of freedom / you will ring me **round**. (R̃.)
6. Be glad in the Lord and *rejoice, you just* ; \*  
exult, all you upright of **heart**. (R̃.)
