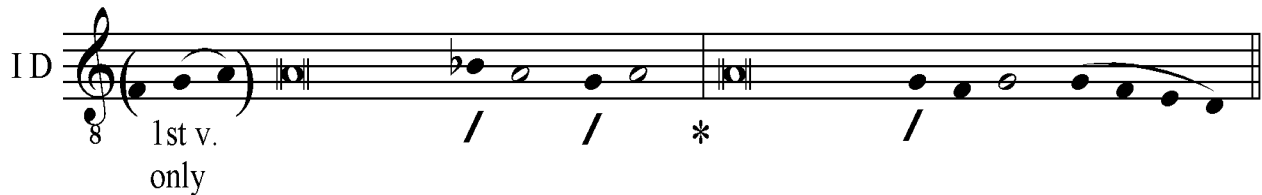
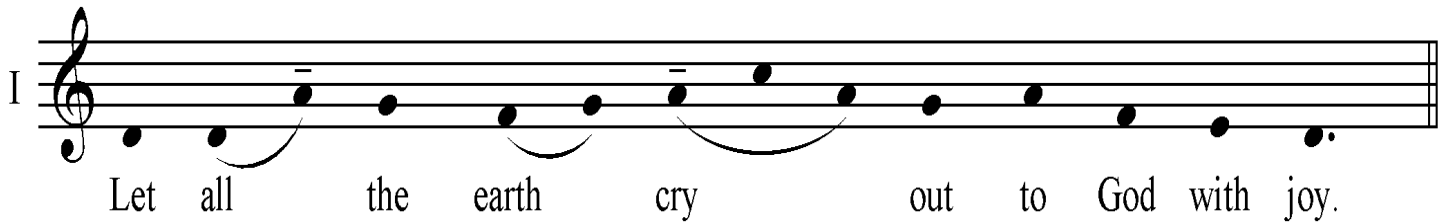


The Fourteenth Sunday of Ordinary Time (Cycle C)
