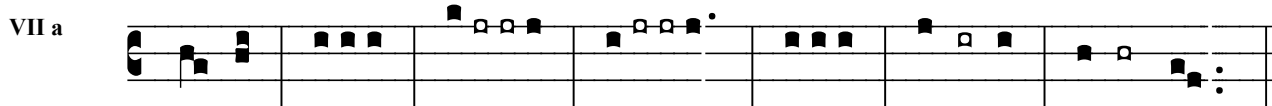


Psalm 33 Nineteenth Sunday Tempus per Annum – C *Psalm 33: 1, 12, 18-19, 20-22*
