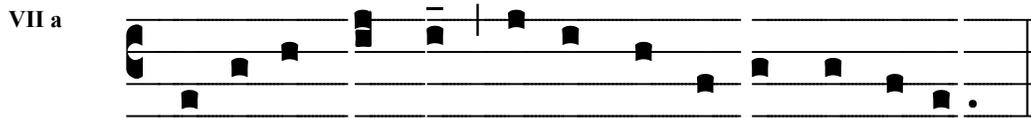
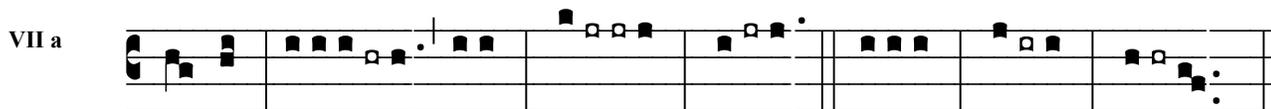


Psalm 68 Twenty-second Sunday Tempus per Annum – C *Psalm 68: 4-5, 6-7, 10-11*

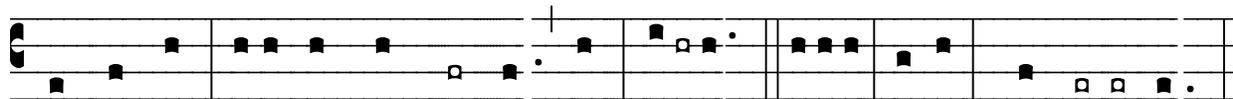
A boun-/tiful rain you showered **down**, O God, upon/ **your** in-/he(ri)tance; *
