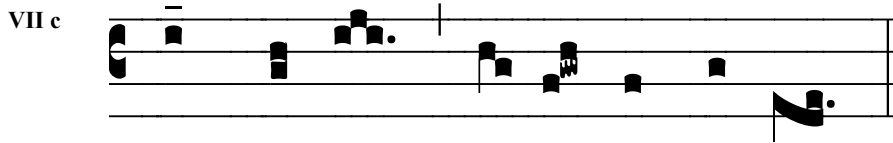
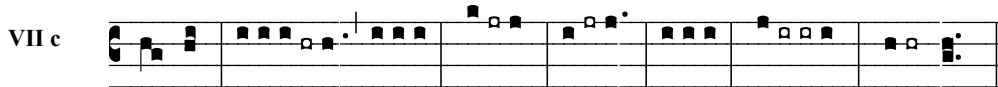

 and looks upon the/ **hea**(vens and) the/ **earth** (be)low?

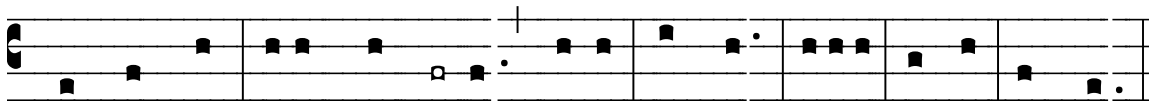
