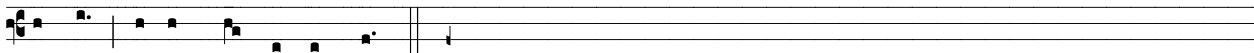
All who see me scoff at me; they mock me with parted lips, they wag their heads: "He relied on the LORD,



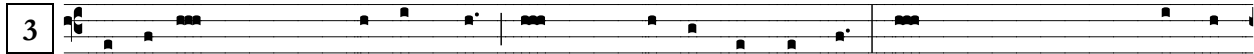
let him deliver him, let him rescue him, if he loves him."



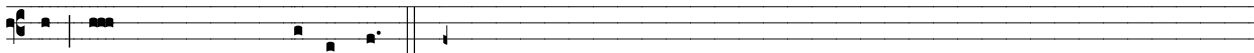
Indeed, many dogs surround me, a pack of evildoers closes in upon me; They have pierced my hands and



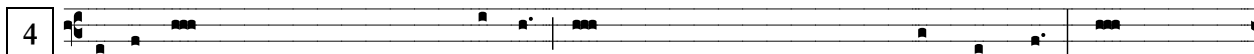
my feet; I can count all my bones.



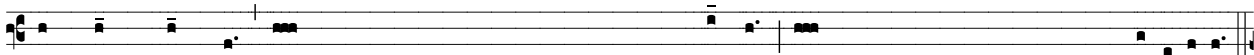
They divide my garments among them, and for my vesture they cast lots. But you, O LORD, be not far from
