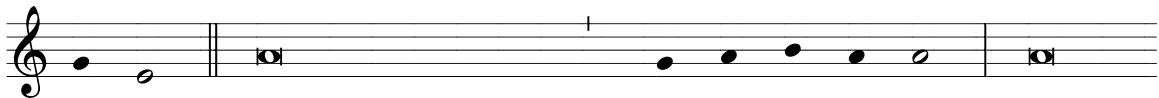

their heads: "He relied on the LORD; let him de-liv-er him, let him

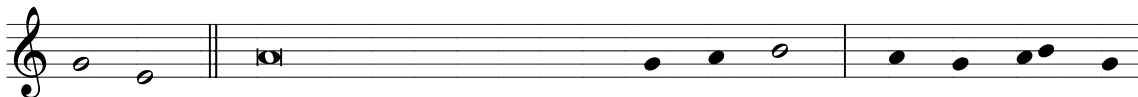
