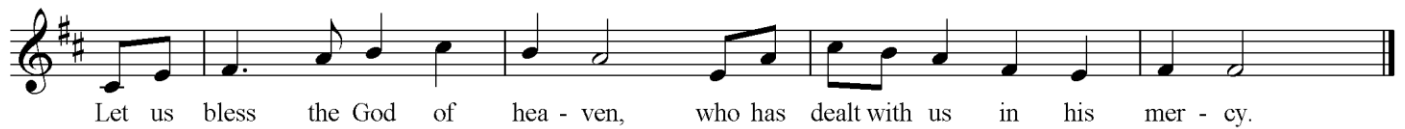

Bless the *Lord* of righteousness,
