





With your rod and your staff that give me cour-age. *R.*



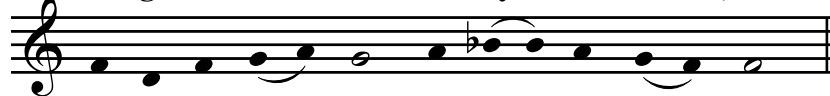
