








 holiness befits your house, O LORD, for length of days. *R.*

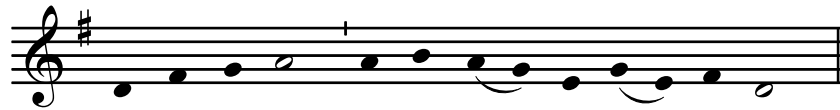
