





and sin - ners shall re - turn to you. *R.*

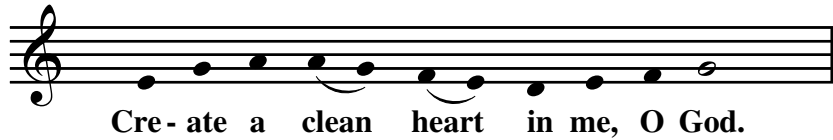
