Won-der-ful are your decrees; therefore I ob-serve them.

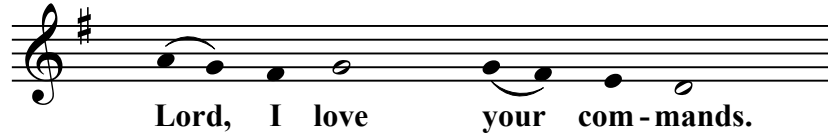
The revelation of your words sheds light, giving under-stand-ing to the sim-ple. *R.*
