

Psalm 138:(8bc) 1-2, 2-3, 6, 8; Tonus Peregrinus


Lord, your love is e - ter - nal; do not for - sake the work of your hands.

when I called, you an - swered me;


3 The LORD is exalted, yet the low - ly he sees,
