
Psalm 80:(Is. 5:7a) 9, 12, 13-14, 15-16, 19-20; Tone I D<sup>2</sup>

and the beasts of the field feed up - on it? *R.*

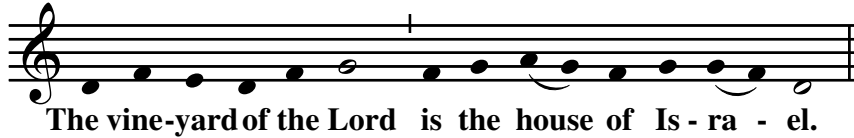
**3**
