





In you, Lord, I have found my peace.

both now and for - ev - er. *R.*

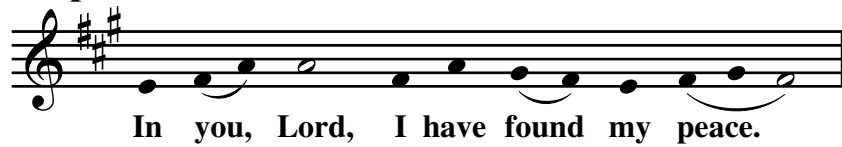
