
Psalm 81:(2a) 3-4, 5-6, 10-11ab; Tone V

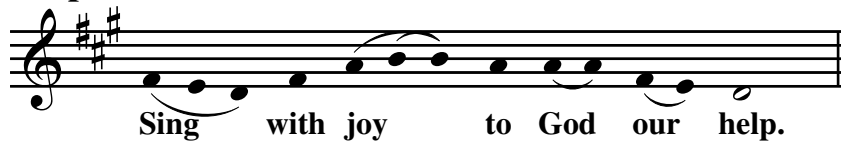
