on waking I shall be content in your pres - ence. *R.*

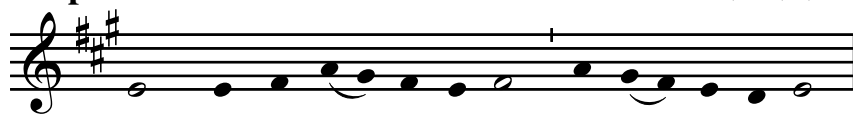
