


I will sing of your sal - va - tion.


Be my rock of refuge,

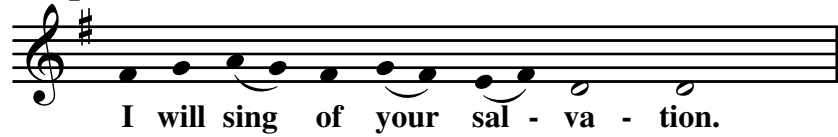
